ORDER GRANTING FULL RESTORATION OF DRIVING PRIVILEGES

ORDERED that Petitioner’s privilege to operate a motor vehicle in the Commonwealth is restored under the authority of Virginia Code § 46.2-360(1), subject to compliance with the two conditions recommended by ASAP; and, the

Department of Motor Vehicles is hereby directed to issue a license to Petitioner,
if all other requirements for issuance of a license are met.
